ORDINANCE NO 554

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO OPEN BURNING WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS; TO REPEAL CONFLICTING ORDINANCES AND SECTIONS; AND TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHAPPELL, NEBRASKA:

Section 1. Section 92.01 of the Municipal Code of Chappell, Nebraska, is amended to read as follows:

92.01 OPEN BURNING BAN.

It shall be unlawful to conduct any burning of waste materials, paper, cardboard, rakings, leaves, grass, weeds, litter, sweepings, either on private property within the city limits of the City of Chappell except as provided in this Section.

Only wood fires contained in portable or permanent grills or fire pits which shall be equipped with a metal screen or lid covering or fires conducted for the purpose of Fire Department training shall be permitted with the city limits of the City of Chappell.

It shall be unlawful to keep, store, or maintain in any building or on any premises, any waste, refuse, debris, rubbish, garbage, or other loose combustible material in such manner as will enhance the danger of fire on said premises when located with the city limits of Chappell.

- Section 2. Any other ordinance or section passed and approved prior to passage, approval, and publication or posting of this ordinance and in conflict with its provisions is repealed.
- Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force, following its passage, approval, and publication or posting as required by law.
