

RESOLUTION 2026-29

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF CHAPPELL, NEBRASKA, TERMINATING THE WATER WATCH (STAGE 1) DECLARED BY RESOLUTION 2026-16;

WHEREAS, the City of Chappell previously adopted Resolution 2026-16 on June 15, 2026 declaring a Water Watch (Stage 1) due to water supply conditions affecting the City's water system; and

WHEREAS, Resolution 2026-16 requested that customers voluntarily reduce non-essential water use and minimize outdoor watering, vehicle washing, and recreational water use; and

WHEREAS, Resolution 2026-16 provides that the Water Watch shall remain in effect until declared by Resolution of the governing body to have ended; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council have determined that the current water supply and system conditions no longer require the continuation of the Water Watch (Stage 1).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHAPPELL, NEBRASKA, that:

1. The Water Watch (Stage 1) declared by Resolution 2026-16 is hereby terminated and declared to have ended.
2. Resolution 2026-16 is hereby rescinded, and the voluntary water-use restrictions and conservation measures established thereunder are no longer in effect.
3. City Officials shall continue to monitor water supply, ground water levels, system pressure and water demand and shall advise the governing body if conditions warrant implementation of any future drought or emergency response stage.
4. This Resolution shall take effect upon its passage, approval and publication in the official City newspaper.
